



TINY PURRS



BABY YUB NUB SCOODIE

Size:

This hood is sized to fit a baby with a head circumference of 16 inches. This is approximately for ages 3 to 9 months depending on the baby. Hood is approximately 19 inches long from the top of the head to the end of the bib, 7 ½ inches from the front to the back across the ear, and 8 inches tall along the back.

Supplies:

- Lion Brand WoolEase Worsted/Medium, Paprika, 1 skein, 197 yards*
*I used nearly the entire skein. If you are cautious, adjusting the size or ignoring gauge, I suggest purchasing a second skein just in case.
- Small amount of worsted weight yarn in brown for inner ear
- Small amount of fuzzy yarn for ear fluffiness/seam (I like Yarn Bee Boucle Tradition Brushed or Patons Divine)
- Hooks in sizes 7/4.5mm, G/4.0mm, and E/3.5mm
- Pet slicker brush (optional)
- Tapestry needle for sewing

Gauge:

14 hdc wide and 12 rows tall equals 4 inches

Stitches:

 (Pattern is written using American terminology)

Ch: Chain

YO: Yarn Over

SC: Single Crochet

HDC: Half Double Crochet

[...]: repeat sequence of stitches in the bracket as instructed

2SCINC: SC twice into the next stitch

HDC2TOG: [YO, insert hook into next st, YO, pull up a loop] **two** times, YO, pull through all 5 loops on the hook

HDC3TOG: [YO, insert hook into next st, YO, pull up a loop] **three** times, YO, pull through all 7 loops on the hook

Hood

With paprika and 4.5 mm hook, Chain 142

1: Starting in 3rd St from the hook, hdc across (140 sts)

2 – 12: Chain 2, turn, hdc across

Finish off after 12 rows.

13: Turn, skip 38 stitches. Join yarn in 39th sc, chain 2, hdc in same stitch (this hdc counts as first st), hdc in next 63 sc.

14 – 19 (6 rows): Turn, chain 2, hdc in each sc across (64 sts)

If you want a deeper fit for a larger head, continue repeating the last row to add depth to the hood.

20: Chain 2, hdc 22 across, [hdc, hdc, hdc2tog] five times, hdc 22 across (59 sts)

21: Chain 2, hdc 22, [hdc, hdc2tog] five times, hdc 22 across (54 sts)

22: Chain 2, hdc 22, [hdc2tog] five times, hdc 22 across (49 sts)

23: Chain 2, hdc 22 across, hdc2tog, hdc, hdc2tog, hdc 22 across (47 sts)

24: Chain 2, hdc 22 across, hdc3tog, hdc 22 across (45 sts)

Finish off, leaving long tail for seaming the back of the hood. Either sew or slip stitch back sides of the hood together.



Ears (Make 2)

With inner ear color and 3.5 mm hook, form a magic loop and work in a spiral.

1: 6 sc in loop

2: 2scinc in each sc around (12 sts)

3: [1 sc, 2scinc] around (18 sts)

4: [2 sc, 2scinc] around (24 sts)

5: [3 sc, 2scinc] around (30 sts)

6: [4 sc, 2scinc] around (36 sts)

Finish off leaving a long tail for sewing to the hood

Fold ear in half. Join fuzzy yarn with 4.0 mm hook.

2scinc in first stitch, sc across, 2scinc in last stitch

Sew in all ends except long tail for attaching ear to hood.

Optional: Brush fuzzy yarn with pet brush to make it fuzzier. (See photo)

Sew ears to upper sides of head. Using scrap yarn, weave in laces on front of scoodie.
