

# Amigurumi Eyeball

\*\*\*\*\*

Easy

Approx. size: 3cm in diameter

You will need:

\*1.5mm Crochet Hook

\*Yarn – Scheepjes Sugar Rush in black, white & chosen eye colour. I've used moonrock. Dark teal is also nice. Try red for something a bit creepy!

\*Stitch marker

\*Stuffing

\*Yarn needle

st = stitch

slst = slip stitch

dc = double crochet (sc in US)

dc2tog = double crochet two together

## Starting at the front of the eye

\*In black

Round 1: Make a magic ring with 6 dc (6)

Round 2: 2 dc in each st, join with slst & fasten off (12)

\*In chosen eye colour join & chain 1

Round 3: (1 dc, 2 dc in next st) 6 times, join with slst to the first st & fasten off (18)

\*In white join & chain 1



\*Worked in rounds without joins from this point on

Round 4: (2 dc, 2 dc in next st) 6 times (24)

Round 5: (3 dc, 2 dc in next st) 6 times (30)

Round 6: (4 dc, 2 dc in next st) 6 times (36)

Rounds 7 to 10: 36 dc (36)

Round 11: (4 dc, dc2tog) 6 times (30)

Round 12: (3 dc, dc2tog) 6 times (24)

\*Stuff.

Round 13: (2 dc, dc2tog) 6 times (18)

Round 14: (1 dc, dc2tog) 6 times (12)

\*Stuff a bit more if necessary.

Round 15: dc2tog 6 times (6)

Fasten off & sew up the hole.

Embroider some red streaks for a more authentic look! A few eyeballs in a glass jar would look super creepy!
