This assignment relates to the following Course Learning Requirements:

CLR 1: Write program code using structured programming, and top-down coding techniques

CLR 5: Modify an existing program according to program specifications

Objective of this Assignment:

The aim of this assignment is to add some CSS selectors to the two pages already created within your project.

Pre-Assignment Instructions:

Big picture

By now, you have two pages created (aboutme.html and contactus.html) but are plain HTML language with some CSS style. In this assignment, you will need to ensure the usage of different CSS selector types.

Assignment Tasks:

Challenge

Based on your implementation of style.css file through last week' solution, and since we did not impose a specific type of selector to use, in this module's task, the goal is to make sure that you are covering all the types of CSS selectors. Your style.css file needs to have at least one implementation of the each of the following selectors types:

- Universal selector
- Type selector
- Class selector
- ID selector
- Attribute selector

Again, what I am asking you is to revisit your previous solution and make sure you cover all types of selectors. Feel free to add more. Be creative and have fun !

Once you are done with your css file, you need to [validate](#) the html documents again and make sure no errors are left in them.
